## **POST-OPERATIVE - SHOULDER SCOPE**

## **General Information:**

- Please stop all Advil and like products 5 days before surgery. You can resume Advil after surgery along with the pain medication.
- Tylenol is not okay to take while taking the narcotics; it is already included in the pain medication.
- You will go home with a large bandage on; this can be removed 24-48 hours after surgery.
- White Steri-Strips will stay on until your post-op. Please wear sling as guided by surgeon.
- You are okay to shower without covering the incision area. Please do not let the shower water stream on top of the incision area; it will be sensitive.
- Dry, plain Band-Aids may be applied to the area after the shower.
- Please do not use any oils, ointments, or lotion on the incision area.
