### **POST-OPERATIVE - SHOULDER LABRAL REPAIR**

#### **General Instructions:**

You will go home with a large bandage over your shoulder area. This can be removed 48 hours after surgery.

#### **Medications:**

Please stop all Advil and like products 5 days before surgery. Do not resume Advil or other NSAIDs after surgery.

No additional Tylenol while taking the narcotics; it is already included in the pain medication.

Please give 24 hours for any medication refills.

#### **Wound Care:**

You will go home with a large bandage on; this can be removed 48 hours after surgery. Any white Steri-Strips and or stitches will be left on until post-op.

You are okay to shower without covering the incision area. Please do not let the shower water stream on top of the incision area; it will be sensitive.

- NO Bathtub
- NO Hot Tub
- No Pool

If you have sutures, pat-dry the area after shower with hand towel and cover sutures with dry Band-Aids.

Please do not use any oils, ointments, or lotion on the incision area.

#### **Immobilizer:**

Please wear the sling/immobilizer day and night until your post-op appointment. Continued use will then be discussed.
