The position is for a full time employed provider, who will be primarily office/clinic based, preferably with a focus on diabetic foot and wound care, and will include surgical management of foot conditions. Position will include performing hospital consults and ongoing participation with Podiatry weekday/weekend call rotation at multiple hospitals (paid call). Surgical management of diabetes-related foot conditions is required. Our new Podiatrist will conduct clinic at our three offices in Northern Colorado with high clinic volume potential.
